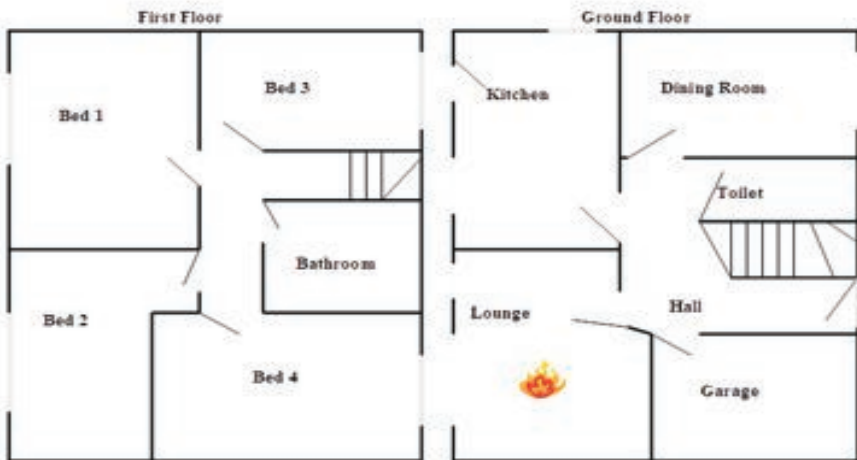

# Arson

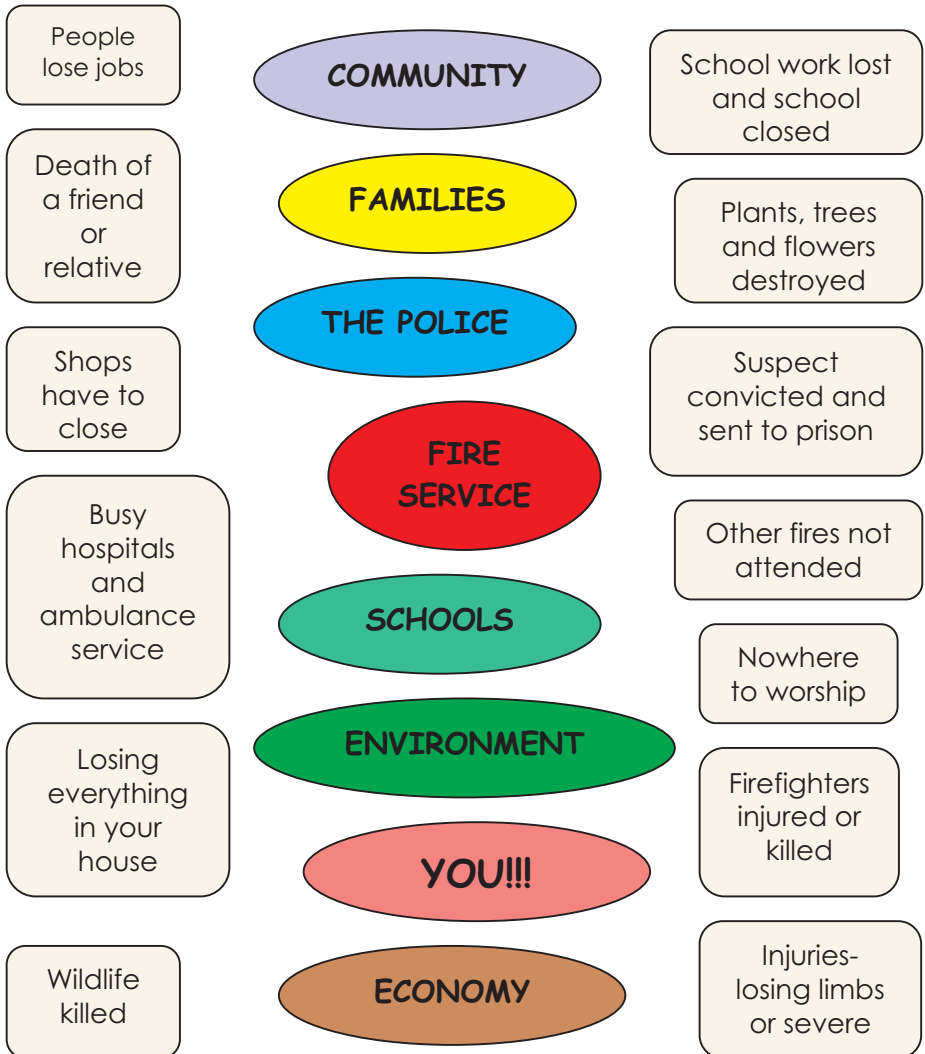
Arson is the crime of setting fire to things on purpose to cause damage to them

- Everyday, the fire service is called to more deliberately started fire than accidental fires.
- Approximately 3,000 people are injured and 100 die in deliberate fires in the UK every year.
- The cost of arson in the UK has risen to **£2.4 billion** every year.
- 10 schools in the UK suffer an arson attack every week, that's over 500 a year!
- 4 places of worship are destroyed every week by arson attacks.
- 175 vehicles are destroyed every week by deliberate fires.
- Arson is against the law. Anyone found guilty of setting fires on purpose could go to prison.
- Buckinghamshire Fire and Rescue work hard with Thames Valley Police and Chiltern District Council to stop arson happening, and to try and catch people who have set fires on purpose.
- The fire brigade has special fire investigation dogs, which can help to tell if a fire has been started on purpose, and how it was started.
- For a person under 18, arson has a sentence of 3 months in prison.
